

PRODUCT RECYCLABILITY GUIDELINES

All the packaging used to preserve our products can be recycled...

As with recycling any food packaging, a quick rinse of each sachet, bottle or cup is recommended prior to disposal.

ProSource & HyFIBER Sachets

All of our pouch & sachet type packaging can be recycled at a wide range of "soft plastic" recycling points.

HyFIBER Bottles, ProSource Jelly and ProSource 20 cups

Both ProSource cups and HyFIBER multi-serve bottles can be widely recycled at home via household curb-side collections*.


- ✓ The foil lid used to seal cups of ProSource Jelly and ProSource 20 can also be recycled. It is recommended that these are rinsed then crunched together with any other aluminium lids or kitchen foil.
- ✓ The plastic wrap on the outer of the HyFIBER bottles can be recycled at a wide range of local "soft plastics" drop off points. [Click here](#) to find your local recycling point - this wrap is categorised as *multi-pack wrapping*.



Outer packaging

All cardboard carrier boxes are widely recyclable, whilst the plastic bag used to retain sachets can be recycled as a "soft plastic". Furthermore, this bag can be used to transport, and be disposed of together with, the empty sachets to your local recycling point.
